- 1. **REGISTRATION**: Registration is from Monday, 15 Jan 2024 through Friday, 8 Mar 2024 on our CYPBMS Parent Portal. For new CYPBMS Accounts, send an email to <u>87fss.jbmdl.youthsports@us.af.mil</u> requesting a CYPBMS Account. Include Sponsor's First/Last Name and the family's primary email address (preferably NOT your .mil address).
 - a. Step 1: ALL CYPBMS accounts must be completed prior to registering for Baseball/Softball. Complete your "Family Information", create your "Child Profile", enter your credit card information for payment into "Manage TAP Settings", and upload all required documents.
 - b. Step 2: From the "Home Page" of CYPBMS, register by selecting "Camp/Instructional" and select "2024 Baseball/Softball". Sessions are grouped according to youth's age. Payment will be processed Friday, 8 Apr 2024. Registrations will not be processed until all forms are uploaded and account is completed with all required information.
- 2. COST: The cost of the Basketball Program is \$75 per youth for all ages. Payments will be processed Monday, 8 Apr 2024 on our CYPBMS Parent Portal. Cost includes team uniform: jersey, pants & socks. *End of Season Team Parties, medals, and tournament team uniforms are not included.
- 3. AGES: Youth Baseball / Softball serves boys and girls ages 3 -16 years old.

- 4. PHYSICALS AND IMMUNIZATION RECORDS: ANNUAL PHYSICALS and IMMUNIZATION RECORDS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL AGES IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM. Please provide a copy at the time of registration. Immunization record must have most recent flu vaccine. For a physical, call your designated Family Practice. In addition, an asthma action plan form and/or food allergy form must be filled out if applicable. A current Part A, AF Form 88, and Part B, if applicable is also needed to complete the registration packet. The above-mentioned forms can be found on gomdl.com or by email 87fss.jbmdl.youthsports@us.af.mil.
- **5. EXPECTATIONS:** Upon completion of registration, the Youth Sports Office will organize teams per division with their coach. Participant's ages 9+ will need to attend Mandatory Skills Assessments so that teams are evenly distributed. The Parents/Coaches Meeting is required, and your attendance is mandatory. Please attend the Mandatory Parents Meeting, to meet your coach and receive the information for the upcoming season. If for some reason you are not able to attend the Parents Meeting, please call the Youth Sports Office at 754.5912/5437 before the season practice begins. Parents will also always practice and promote proper conduct while always promoting positive reinforcement both on and off the field.
- **6. PRACTICES AND GAMES:** All divisions' practices will utilize the 7 baseball/softball fields located at both at Dix and Falcons Court North (FCN). START Smart, Pee Wee, and Tee Ball will play in-house against each other and will not travel off the installation. Rookies, Minors, Juniors, and Seniors divisions play other teams from other Little Leagues in District 13 both on and off base. Coaches will contact Parents/Guardians of players of any delays or cancellations of games due to inclement weather and/or field safety once confirmation is provided from the Youth Sports Office. Parents of children with special needs must be present at all at practices and games. If you are unsure of practice or game times, please contact your coach or the 87 FSS Youth Sports Office. The 87 FSS Youth Sports Program welcomes all forms of positive reinforcement and enthusiasm from all participants.
- 7. **COACHES:** All volunteer coaches must be certified by a Youth Sports Clinician and through the National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA). See Important Dates on reverse side for the next certification training. The 87 FSS Youth Sports Program adopts the NYSCA standards of safety and coaching etiquette. The NYSCA teaches psychological and emotional needs of children while in youth sports, basic sport skills, sportsmanship, and emphasis on participation rather than winning. In addition, each coach must complete an installation records check (IRC) which will be checked through the McGuire Family Advocacy Program.

- **8.** *TRANSPORTATION*: Transportation will not be provided by the 87 FSS Youth Sports Office. It is the sole responsibility of the parents/guardians.
- **9.** *REFUND POLICY*: After the 1st of March, *NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED*. Unfortunately, program costs are fixed costs; therefore, the Youth Sports Program incurs costs whether a youth finishes a complete season or not.

REQUESTS: We will attempt to honor special requests in writing under the comments section for Tee ball and Coach Pitch leagues ONLY. However, due to the number of requests, we cannot guarantee your request will be honored. Special requests cannot be honored in any of the other leagues.
