







Eligibility Priority

OI-34-101-2

- 1. Active Duty/Reserve Military Living On Base
- 2. Active Duty/Reserve Military Living off Base
- 3. Other authorized personel (Based on Availability)

Guests must be assigned to our base to qualify. Those living off base must be within a $50\,\mathrm{Mile}$ Radius

Storage Registration

You will need to bring your state issued vehicle registration card, proof of insurance and DoD ID card to Outdoor Recreation, building 6045.

ALL ITEMS STORED MUST BE PROPERLY REGISTERED AND DISPLAY CURRENT LICENSE PLATES AT ALL TIMES.

Fees

Our office charges guests based on a yearly fee. Fees will be charged at the beginning of each calendar year (CY) using our RecTrac 3.1 System. RecTrac 3.1 encripts clients credit/debit cards and will only be charged when a bill is run. Particiaption in the RecTrac 3.1 system is required to store an item in our lot. If clients are assigned a space after the new year has begun the rate goes as follows:

The following policies <u>must be followed at all times</u> or you may lose the privilege of using the storage lot:

- Stored items must be parked within the confines of their assigned space only. Parking in a different space may result in immediate contract cancellation.
- No part of a stored item will extend over the grass, into another customer's spot, or extend
 beyond the limits of the assigned spot: item must be inside the white lines to each side and the
 imaginary line at the opening connecting the ends of the lines.
- Stored items must be in operational condition at all times and tires must be inflated.
- Inaccordance with IAW OI 34 101-2 all items stored must be registered & insured.
- State license registration/tags must be current and permanently mounted to stored item <u>at all times</u>. Only Active Duty members are authorized to have out of state registration on their item per New Jersey State Law, all others must be registered in the state of New Jersey.
- Liability/comprehensive insurance must be kept current at all times.
- All watercraft must be secured on a trailer.
- Minor maintenance, such as replacing light bulbs, tire changes, polishing/cleaning are permitted, so long as they do not interfere or impede on the space(s) next to yours.
- Extensive maintenance, such as changing engine oil or coolants, replacing motor parts, brake work, etc. is prohibited.
- Vehicles must be properly secured. This is especially critical to prevent movement and/or items
 becoming airborne during severe weather. This is to protect your property as well as the
 protection of other customer's property. Inexpensive plastic chocks are known to blow away
 and are not recommended, heavier chocks or bricks should be used.
- UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will customers change storage spots once assigned nor can a spot be directly transferred when a stored item is sold.
- UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES are guests permitted to share and/or exchange their access code to unauthorized user. If the office is notified of this exchange or allowance their storage space will be put under investigation and may be revoked.
