Housekeeping We strive daily to provide you with a clean room with sufficient linens, towels, and amenities, unless you have a "Do Not Disturb" sign on your door. If this sign is present, the housekeeper will not provide any services. In order to provide daily housekeeping service to your room, you must remove your "Do Not Disturb" sign not later than 1300 hours. "Do Not Disturb" may not be posted more than 72 hours. Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.

Daily service requirements include:

Mail Military personnel on temporary duty (TDY) or permanent change of station (PCS) status to NSA Lakehurst and want to receive personal mail during their stay, should contact the Postal Service Center (PSC) about getting a P.O. Box for the duration of their stay. Temporary Duty or Permanent Change of Station orders may be required during registration for a P.O. box. The PSC is located, 38 Lansdown Rd, hours of operation 1000-1300 or call (723)323-2534 if you have questions about getting a mail box. Personnel mail cannot be delivered through front desk. Other commercial carriers such as Fed Ex, UPS, DHL, etc., can also deliver packages to the Postal Service Center however they will not accept COD deliveries. For all outgoing mail, there is a letter box in the front lobby for your convenience. Pickup is Monday – Friday at 1500 hours.

Maintenance Lodging Maintenance and Civil Engineering strive to maintain high standards of maintenance in all of our rooms. Contact the front desk with anyneeded repair or replacement of items in your room.

Messages To obtain your messages, please refer to the telephone instructions provided in this directory.

Occupant All occupants are responsible for any damages to the rooms or furnishings. Guardians are responsible for the actions of their dependents. Charges for damages beyond fair wear and tear will be assessed based on a case by case basis. Never leave young children unattended.

Parking Our facility has a parking area for your use. Please help to keep this area clean. Vehicle maintenance, changing oil, washing cars, etc. is not permitted. See the Base Auto Hobby Shop for these purposes. Boats, motorcycles, trailers, etc. are permitted in parking area only on the day of arrival. Large, oversized vehicles must also be removed from the parking lots after your day of arrival. The Auto Hobby Shop has a parking area that is available to PCS and TDY personnel with oversized vehicles.

PaymentAll Air Force Lodging guests must provide a valid credit card at
check in or be required to pay in advance with cash or check for
anticipated room charges. Official travelers, TDY/PCS, must use
the Government Travel Card (GTC) to make room reservations and
to pay all lodging fees unless exempt from GTC use. Please
contact the lodging manager for more information

Personal Effects Lodging is not responsible for your valuables. Personal Property should be secured in the in room safe or taken with you when you leave the room. Housekeepers are instructed not to disturb a guest's personal property at any time. OCCUPANT "DO AND DON'TS"

DO

- Notify a Guest Representative by dialing "0" from your room telephone if you have problems

ENERGY CONSERVATION TIPS

Fire Safety

Please familiarize yourself with the location of the nearest fire exit stairway. In the event of a fire, please move quickly, but calmly, to the nearest exit. It is mandatory that all fire or smoke incidents be reported to the fire department. Emergency evacuation maps are located on the **inside of your room's door.** Please call **"911" for Emergencies**. Non-emergencies, call **Front Desk at "0"** or the Fire Department at 323-4000

Please help us by observing the following rules.

- Do not touch or tamper with the smoke detectors in living areas or bedrooms. If your smoke detector is activating, please contact the front desk.
- Do not tamper with fire extinguishers. Tampering or unnecessary discharge of fire extinguishers will result in your removal from the facilities.
- Do not smoke in room. All rooms are NONSMOKING.
- Do not store highly flammable liquids (gasoline, charcoal lighter, flammable paint, etc.) in your room
- Do not use unauthorized cooking or heating devices in your room. UL approved coffee pots are provided.
- If your room has a kitchen, do not leave cooking equipment unattended.
- Do not place hot appliances such as irons, coffee pots, etc., in closets, cabinets or drawers.
- Do not overload electrical circuits.
- Do not leave televisions, radios, or personal, electrical items on in your absence.
- Do follow good housekeeping practices.
- If detected, report low pressure fire extinguishers to the front desk.

Occupant Safety

Your safety and the security of your personal property are of the utmost concern to those of us who welcome you welcome you as our guest. We urge you to take advantage of the following suggestions

All American Inn is not responsible for your valuables. Do not leave money or valuables in your room. Please take such items with you or secure in your in room safe

When away from or while occupying your room, always lock your door even if you are just leaving for a few minutes.

Do not admit persons in your room without first making identification. Rooms have a "peep hole" provided in the door. If there is any doubt about a person's true identity or purpose, please contact the front desk.

Safeguard your key. If you do not wish to leave the property with your key, leave it with the Guest Services Desk upon departure and have a new key made upon return. Do not leave it in your room or in the door. Do not give your keys to others.

Warning Signals

SEVERE WEATHER:

Thunderstorm Watch-Heavy thunderstorm activity has been sighted. Prepare to take shelter

Thunderstorm Warning-Rain, storm winds, and possible hail. Seek Shelter

Tornado Watch-Weather conditions are favorable for the development of tornadoes.

Tornado Warning-Tornado has actually been sighted. Take shelter.

TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS

- Stay informed. Monitor the local radio or television station for the latest weather advisory
- If you are in the watch area, be prepared to take shelter. For protection against tornadoes, you should select a central hallway area or centrally located room on the lowest floor of your duty section or quarters away from windows, doorways, and wide ceilings
- Preposition sturdy tables, blankets, flashlights, etc. in the area selected for use during tornadoes
- Unless a tornado warning issued, you should not further interrupt your normal routine, except remain alert for the approach of threatening weather conditions or the termination of the tornado watch.

3-5 Minute Steady Tone-Alert Signal. Imminent peacetime emergencies only.
3-5 Minute Wavering Tone-Attack Warning. Actual attack is imminent or in progress.
Take immediate shelter or other protective actions.
30-Second duration wavering or steady Tone-Test Signal. Testing of alert signal only.
Take no action.
